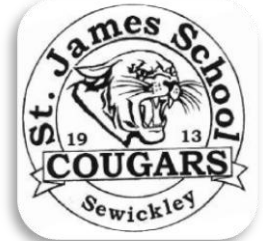

### **Cross Country Team Competes at Hopewell Park**

Congratulations to the Cross Country Team on their first away meet this season! The meet took place at Hopewell Park. Five teams competed in the meet: St. James,

Holy Redeemer, Sts Peter and Paul, and Divine Mercy. The meet was 1.8 miles of challenging hills through the woods. It rained all day leading up to the meet so the runners had to navigate through muddy terrain. The bad weather didn't seem to affect our runners. In fact the first runners to cross the finish line were Bailey Tyler of our varsity girls team and Victoria Michalenko of our JV girl's team.

Also competing for the girls varsity team were Elizabeth Michalenko who placed 6<sup>th</sup>, and Caroline Jackson who placed 15<sup>th</sup>.
